St George was probably a soldier living in Palestine at the beginning of the fourth century. He was martyred at Lydda in about the year 304, and became known throughout the East as 'The Great Martyr'. Although there were churches in England dedicated to George before the Norman Conquest, he only replaced Edward the Confessor as Patron Saint of England following the Crusades, as returning soldiers brought his cult back with them to these shores. His Feast Day is celebrated at the beginning of this term, on April 23rd.
