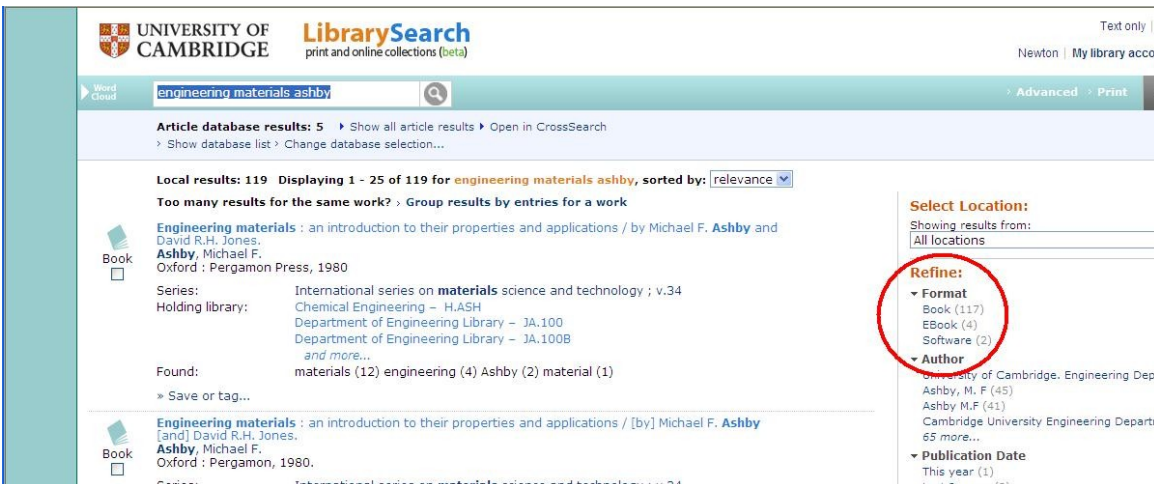
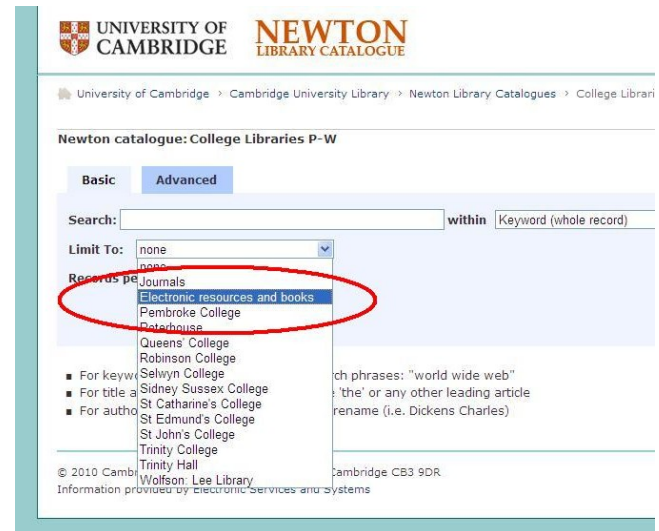
## Searching for e-books

E-books are catalogued on [Newton](#) and on [Heritage](#), and any available records for them will appear when you search by author, title, keyword etc.

The illustrations on this page show how to refine a search to look for electronic resources only.

[Newton](#) and [LibrarySearch](#) will generally be more up-to-date for this purpose than Heritage.

If an e-book is not found on Heritage, you should try [Newton](#) or [LibrarySearch](#) before concluding that it is not available.



*Books published by Cambridge University Press, which form part of [Cambridge Collections Online](#), may be difficult to find on Heritage.*
