



ST JOHNS COLLEGE SPORTS GROUND CODE OF CONDUCT

1. **NO DOGS** are to be taken onto the sports ground under any circumstances except for registered assistance dogs
2. **STUDS/SPIKES/BLADES** should not be worn inside the pavilion/cricket bays at **ANY TIME** the captain should inform their players and the opposition
3. Under no circumstances must **BLADES/SPIKES/STUDS** including moulded studs on the Astro carpet at any time. The only shoes acceptable are dimpled Astro shoes or flat training shoes
4. No training may take place on any match pitch unless permission has been granted by the member of staff on duty
5. No cycling on any grass areas at any time, cycling is only permitted on **pathways**.
6. Details of pitch and changing room usage can be found on the information board on the front of the pavilion
7. The pavilion and pitch should be left in the same condition as it was found in when you first arrived, all large pieces of rubbish must be picked up and put in the bins provided
8. When entering and exiting the sports ground please keep noise levels to a minimum and do not obstruct or use any neighbouring properties to park or turn vehicles around
9. **STUDS/BLADES must not be worn** on the cricket square when retrieving balls, someone with flat shoes should retrieve the ball
10. If you require the toilet at any point during a match you can use the toilet on the south side of the pavilion where boots do not need to be removed
11. The astro pitch/hard courts must be entered through one of the gates **DO NOT CLIMB OVER** and when leaving the astro pitch/hard courts put rubbish in bins provided and shut the gate

- 12. All members of St Johns, Magdalene, Sidney Sussex can bring up to 3 guests when playing individual sports**
- 13. All external users need to complete and return a booking form before the event/match takes place**
- 14. Only food prepared on the premises may be consumed unless the appropriate forms have been filled in and returned before the event/match takes place**
- 15. The college will provide two bins 1 general waste and 1 recycling, once these bins are full the external user will have to remove and dispose of any additional rubbish in an appropriate way**
